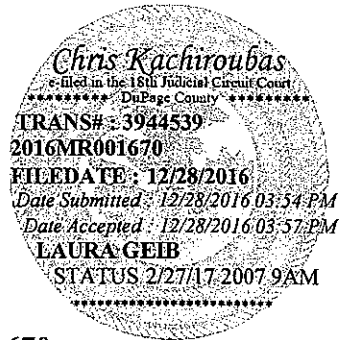



VERIFIED PETITION FOR ELECTION CONTEST

The Petitioners herein Andrew Schmidt, Kirsten Schmidt, Karen Weber, Bradford Tocher and Edward Corcoran (collectively, hereinafter, "Petitioners"), pro se, bring this action pursuant to Article 23 of the Election Code which sets forth procedures to challenge ballot, voting, other election irregularities and results of an election, generally, 10 ILCS 5/23-1.1a, et seq., and the procedures for contesting a referendum election, 10 ILCS 5/23-24, Article 12 of the Election Code which sets forth procedures directing the election authority to publish the election notice, 10 ILCS 5/23-12-5, and the election laws of the State of Illinois, against Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois (herein, the "Defendant").

Petitioners hereby contest the purported referendum as administered by the DuPage County Board of Election Commissioners (herein, the "Election Board") and respectfully request that the Court declare the referendum placed on the ballot by the Defendant at the general election held on November 8, 2016 (herein, the "Election") to be invalid.

In support of this contest and prayer for relief, the Petitioners state as follows:

I.

GENERAL FACTS

1. The general election held on the 8th day of November, 2016 was an election held after July 1, 1999. (10 ILCS 5/12-5. Notice for public questions.)

2. Each of the Petitioners voted at said Election and believes a mistake was committed, being a material irregularity in the conduct of the election, in each and every precinct in the voting district, as detailed in the paragraphs set forth below.

3. Section 12-5 of the Election Code states, in part:

“Not more than 30 days nor less than 10 days before the date of a regular election at which a public question is to be submitted to the voters of a political or governmental subdivision, and at least 20 days before an emergency referendum, the election authority shall publish notice of the referendum. The notice shall be published once in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the political or governmental subdivision. The notice shall also be given at least 10 days before the date of the election by posting a copy of the notice at the principal office of the election authority.” (Emphasis added)

4. The Defendant’s board of education adopted a resolution (herein, the “Resolution”) during a meeting held on August 15, 2016 (herein, the “Meeting”) in accordance with the Open Meetings Act of the State of Illinois to submit a proposition for the issuance of school building bonds to the voters at the general election to be held on the 8th day of November, 2016. Within the Resolution, the language of the proposition is stated as follows:

“Shall the Board of Education of Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois (located primarily in Hinsdale and Clarendon Hills, Illinois), improve the site of and build and equip a new school building and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$53,329,194 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?”

5. On August 17, 2016, Assistant Superintendent Kenneth Surma (herein, “Surma”) filed on behalf of the Defendant a) the Minutes of the Meeting, b) the signed Resolution adopted at the

Meeting, c) the "Certification of Resolution and Minutes" of the school board Secretary, and d) a "Filing Certificate" with Executive Director Robert T. Saar (herein, "Saar") of the Election Board in the office of the DuPage County Election Commission. Surma's signature appears on the "Certification of Filing" dated August 17, 2016 as the person filing the referendum. (See "Certification of Filing" attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference.)

6. On August 17, 2016, Saar certified that the above referendum question had been filed in the office of the DuPage County Election Commission. Saar's signature appears on the "Certification of Filing" dated August 17, 2016 as the person certifying the filing the referendum.

7. Section 5 of the Resolution filed with the Election Board states:

"Section 5. That the Executive Director of the Election Board and the County Clerk of Cook County (the "County Clerk") shall give notice of the Election, including the Spanish, Chinese and American Indian translations thereof as deemed required by law by the Executive Director and the County Clerk (the "Notice"), in accordance with the general election law by (i) publishing the Notice once not more than 30 nor less than 10 days prior to the dates of the Election in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District, and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the Election Board and the County Clerk."
(Emphasis added)

8. Section 7 of the Resolution filed with the Election Board states:

"Section 7. That it is hereby found and determined that the Hinsdalean is a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the 'Election Code')."

9. Section 8 of the Resolution filed with the Election Board states that the "Notice" required by Section 5 of the Resolution is to include specific language regarding the proposition and the opening and closing of the polls.

10. Section 12 of the Resolution filed with the Election Board states:

“*Section 12.* That the Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the general election law.”

11. Paragraph 4 of the “Filing Certificate” filed by Surma with Saar on August 17, 2016 states:

“4. That notice that the Question will be submitted to the voters of the District at the Election, including the Spanish translation thereof (the ‘*Notice*’), will be given as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended, by (a) publishing the Notice once not more than 30 nor less than 10 days prior to the date of the Election in the *Hinsdalean*, being a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District, and (b) posting a copy of the Notice at my principal office at least 10 days before the date of the Election, as set forth in Section 5 of said resolution, and that the Notice will be substantially in the form set forth in Section 8 of said resolution.” (Emphasis added)

12. The first day for the election authority to publish a notice of any question of public policy to be voted upon within the jurisdiction was Tuesday, October 11, 2016. (See: *Election and Campaign Finance Calendar* (2016), document pages 43-44, compiled and published by The State Board of Elections. (Link as of December 27, 2016: (<https://www.elections.il.gov/Downloads/ElectionInformation/PDF/2016ElectionCalendar.pdf>))

13. **HINSDALE SUBURBAN LIFE (NEWSPAPER):** A publisher’s certificate with a clipping of the notice attached, as described in Section 1 of the Notice By Publication Act, 715 ILCS 5/0.01, *et seq.*, provides proof of the publication of the “notice” required by Section 12-5. The “Certificate of the Publisher: Suburban Life” from Shaw Media publisher Karen Pletsch, dated October 7, 2016 and addressed to the DuPage County Election Commission states: “A notice, a true copy of which is attached, was published 1 time in the Suburban Life, namely one time per week for one week. Publication of the notice was made in the newspaper, dated and published on 10/5/16, 10/6/16, 10/7/16.” (Emphasis added) (See “Certification of Publisher”

attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by this reference.)

14. **THE HINSDALEAN (NEWSPAPER):** Within the Thursday, October 6, 2016 edition of *The Hinsdalean*, a supplement was inserted which contained the published “General Election Notice” as published by the Election Board. (See photocopies of page one of supplement as well the page containing the Defendant’s bond proposition attached hereto as Exhibit C and incorporated herein by this reference.)

15. On Friday, December 2, 2016, Saar signed the “Certificate of Filing and Abstract” (herein, the “Abstract”) regarding the Defendant’s ballot proposition. (See “Certification of Filing and Abstract” attached hereto as Exhibit D and incorporated herein by this reference.)

a. Attached to the Abstract (Exhibit A), Saar includes a “true, correct and complete copy of said notice” as posted at the principal office of the DuPage County Election Commission. (See page 3 of 9)

b. Attached to the Abstract (Exhibit B), Saar includes a copy of the Official Ballot used in DuPage County for the purpose of voting on the Defendant’s proposition at the Election. (See pages 4-5 of 9)

c. Attached to the Abstract (Exhibit C), Saar includes the complete record of the canvass of votes cast. (See page 6-9 of 9)

16. Within the Abstract signed by Saar on Friday, December 2, 2016, Saar failed to certify that the proposition was published in accordance with Section 12-5 of the Election Code’s requirement that “Not more than 30 days nor less than 10 days before the date of a regular election at which a public question is to be submitted to the voters of a political or governmental subdivision, and at least 20 days before an emergency referendum, the election authority shall publish notice of the referendum.”

II.

ELECTION IRREGULARITIES

17. Upon information and belief, the Defendant's board of education stated within its Resolution that *The Hinsdalean* was to be considered by the Election Board to be the local, community newspaper having general circulation in the political or governmental subdivision.

18. Upon information and belief, the State Board of Elections had determined that Tuesday, October 11, 2016 was the first day for the Election Board to properly publish notice of the Defendant's proposition in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the political or governmental subdivision.

19. Upon information and belief, the Election Board published between Wednesday, October 5, 2016 and Friday, October 7, 2016, inclusive, all election notices for all candidates and propositions to be voted upon at the Election.

20. Upon information and belief, the records and files of the Election Board do not contain a single record demonstrating that the Election Board properly published the notice of the Defendant's proposition on or after October 11, 2016 in accordance with Section 12-5 of the Election Code.

21. Upon information and belief, the records and files of the Election Board do not contain a record ("publisher's certificate") from the publisher of *The Hinsdalean* that includes a clipping of the notice, as described in Section 1 of the Notice By Publication Act, 715 ILCS 5/0.01, *et seq.*, providing proof of the publication of the "notice" required by Section 12-5.

22. Accordingly, the validity of the Defendant's ballot proposition is in doubt due to the apparent failure on the part of the Election Board to follow the statutory procedures found within Section 12-5 of the Election Code of Illinois, as amended. ("Contest of validity of an election differs from contest of its result in that in former **ultimate issue is whether or not the election was valid, irrespective of its result**, while contest of result assumes a valid election but that for

various reasons the legal ballots cast were improperly counted or the result reached by the canvassing board was erroneous.” *Village of Hinsdale v. DuPage County Court*, 281 Ill. App.571 (Ill. App. Ct. 1935)) (Emphasis added)

III.

CONCLUSION

23. That based on the foregoing, the Petitioners argue that the Defendant’s ballot initiative (Bond Referendum) of November 8, 2016 is invalid due to improper notice being published by the Election Board.

24. That based on the foregoing, the Election Code of Illinois does not provide a statutory remedy for either the Defendant or the Election Board.

25. That based on the foregoing, there is no cure available to the Defendant or the Election Board which could make the election valid.

26. That based on the foregoing, the Judicial Branch is not empowered under the Constitution of the State of Illinois to validate an otherwise invalid election.

27. That this Petition is verified and under oath and the allegations made result in the Defendant’s ballot initiative of November 8, 2016 to be invalid regardless of the results.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners respectfully request this Honorable Court grant the relief set forth in this Petition, and proceed in accordance with the Election Code of Illinois:


- A. Ascertain and declare by a judgment entered of record, the Defendant’s ballot initiative (Bond Referendum) of November 8, 2016 to be invalid.
- B. Cause a certified copy of said judgment to forthwith be made by the Clerk of the Court and transmitted to the Defendant, the Election Board, and the County Clerk of Cook

County.

C. For whatever other relief this Court deems equitable and just.

MINUTES of a regular public meeting of the Board of Education of Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, held in the Administration Center, 115 West 55th Street, Clarendon Hills, Illinois, in said School District at 7:00 o'clock P.M., on the 15th day of August, 2016.

The meeting was called to order by the President and upon the roll being called, Mridu Garg, the President, and the following members were physically present at said location:

The following members were allowed by a majority of the members of the Board of Education in accordance with and to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the Board of Education to attend the meeting by video or audio conference: None

No member was not permitted to attend by video or audio conference.

The following members were absent and did not participate in the meeting in any manner or to any extent whatsoever: None

The President announced that the Board of Education would consider the adoption of a resolution providing for and requiring the submission of a proposition for the issuance of School Building Bonds to the voters of the District at the general election to be held on November 8, 2016.

Whereupon Member Marty Turak presented and the Secretary read in full a resolution as follows:

RESOLUTION providing for and requiring the submission of a proposition for the issuance of School Building Bonds to the voters of Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois, at the general election to be held on the 8th day of November, 2016.

* * *

WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "*School Board*") of Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois (the "*District*"), has considered the existing school facilities and the improvements and extensions necessary to be made thereto in order that the same will adequately serve the educational needs of the District; and

WHEREAS, the School Board does hereby find and determine that it is necessary and in the best interests of the District that the School Board improve the site of and build and equip a new school building (the "*Project*") at an estimated cost of \$53,329,194; and

WHEREAS, the School Board does hereby find and determine that the Project is needed to provide a quality educational program; and

WHEREAS, there are insufficient funds on hand and available to pay the costs of the Project; and

WHEREAS, before the School Board can borrow money and issue bonds for such purposes, a proposition therefor (the "*Proposition*") must be submitted to the voters of the District and be approved by a majority of the voters of the District voting on such proposition at an election to be held in and for the District and it is deemed advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the District that the Proposition be submitted to the voters of the District at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election law:

(ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the Election Board and the County Clerk.

Section 6. That the Secretary of the School Board shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the District.

Section 7. That it is hereby found and determined that the Hinsdalean is a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District as required by Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "*Election Code*").

Section 8. That the Notice required by Sections 5 and 6 shall include the following:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the general election to be held on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2016, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois:

Shall the Board of Education of Community Consolidated School District Number 181, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois (located primarily in Hinsdale and Clarendon Hills, Illinois), improve the site of and build and equip a new school building and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$53,329,194 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

The polls at the election will be open at 6:00 o'clock A.M. and will continue to be open until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of that day.


