The notice shall also be given at least 10 days 3 4 before the date of the election by posting a copy of the notice 5 at the principal office of the election authority. The local election official shall also post a copy of the notice at the 6 principal office of the political or governmental subdivision, 7 8 or if there is no principal office at the building in which the 9 governing body of the political or governmental subdivision 10 held its first meeting of the calendar year in which the referendum is being held. The election authority and the 11 political or governmental subdivision may, but are not required 12 13 to, post the notice electronically on their World Wide Web 14 pages. The notice, which shall appear over the name or title of 15 the election authority, shall be substantially in the following 16 form:

17 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the election to be held 18 on (insert day of the week), (insert date of election), the 19 following proposition will be submitted to the voters of 20 (name of political or governmental subdivision):

1 (Name or title of the election authority) 2 The notice shall also include any additional information required by the statute authorizing the public question. The 3 4 notice may include an explanation, in neutral and plain 5 language, of the question and its purposes supplied by the governing body of the political or governmental subdivision to 6 whose voters the question is to be submitted. The notice shall 7 set forth the precincts and polling places at which the 8 9 referendum will be conducted only in the case of emergency 10 referenda. 11 (b) Notice of any public question published in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the 12

13 political or governmental subdivision to which such public 14 question relates more than 30 days but not more than 35 days 15 prior to the general election held on November 8, 2016 that 16 otherwise complies with the requirements of this Section is sufficient notice to satisfy the newspaper publication 17 requirement of this Section, such notice shall for all purposes 18 19 be deemed to have been given in accordance with this Section, 20 any bonds approved by the voters at such election are hereby authorized to be issued in accordance with applicable law 21 22 without further referendum approval and taxes to be levied 23 pursuant to any limiting rate increases approved by the voters 24 at such election are hereby authorized to be levied and 25 extended without further referendum approval.
