The Comprehensive School Climate Inventory (CSCI) is a nationally-recognized school climate survey that provides an in-depth profile of our school community's particular strengths and needs.

The CSCI measures **fourteen essential dimensions** of a healthy school climate in five broad categories:

- Safety
- Teaching and Learning
- Interpersonal Relationships
- Institutional Environment
- Leadership & Efficacy

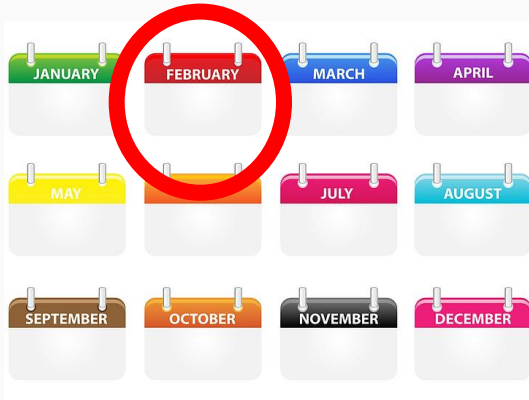
Example Scoring
