What does it measure?

The CSCI measures 12 essential dimensions of a healthy school climate in 5 categories:

- Safety
- Teaching and Learning
- Interpersonal Relationships
- Social Media
- Institutional Environment

Two additional dimensions for staff only: Leadership & Professional Relationships

Administration Window & Score Interpretation

Two-week window utilized with no other assessments or religious holidays when students will be absent/fasting

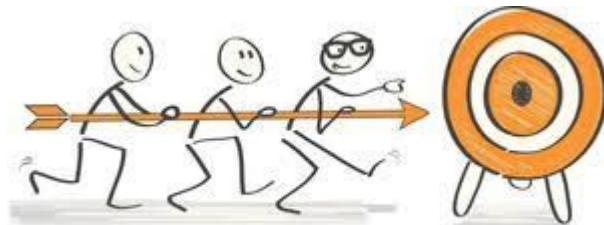

Score Consistency

What does this mean?



- We observe a consistent level of positive culture across respondent groups, regardless of the building the student attends and/or the building to which the staff member is assigned.
