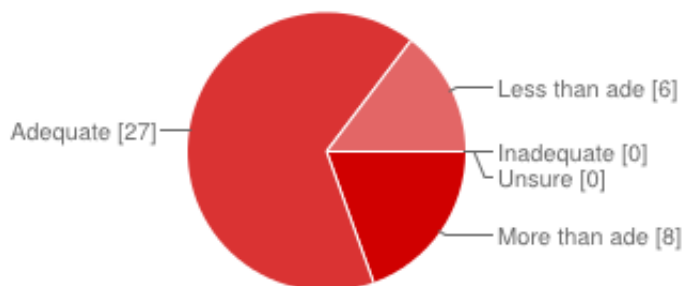

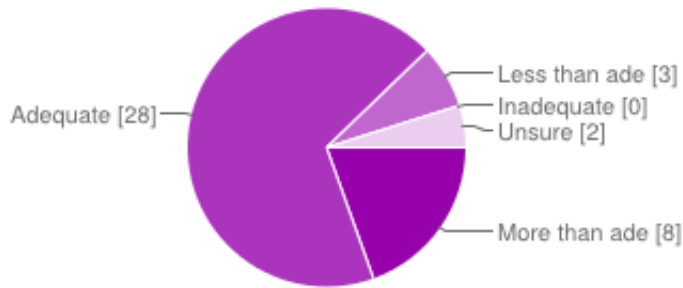

The parents block the lanes so that no traffic can get through which could be a problem. The parents drive through the staff parking lot at high rates of speed or they park their cars behind staff cars thus blocking staff cars in the parking space. many parent double park in the parking lot or enter from the bus loop which is dangerous, especially when there is rain or snow. Also, most parents block access to/from Chicago Avenue. This is especially a problem when Prospect parents line up at dismissal time in the bus loop and often block exit from CHMS/completely tie up Chicago Avenue. Again, this is especially a problem in rain/snow. It can be difficult to exit CHMS between 3:-3:20 Parents drive through the main lot, entering from the east end to avoid the line from the west bound entrance. This can block staff from parking spaces and is dangerous for pedestrians. The drop-off area becomes very crowded, with long lines of cars waiting on the street. Occasionally, frustrated drivers try to pass the line of cars, putting other cars at risk. However, the situation is better this year than last, since some restrictions have been placed on parents' access to the staff parking lot from

the eastern end.

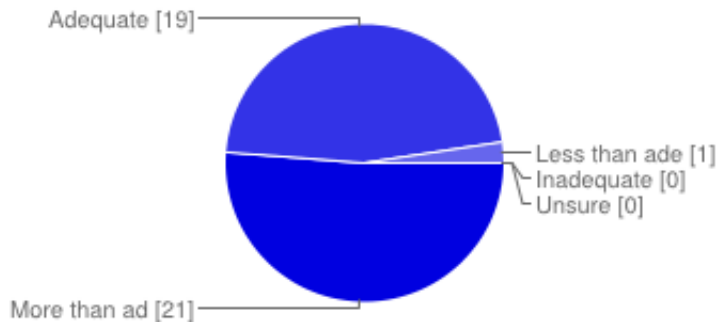

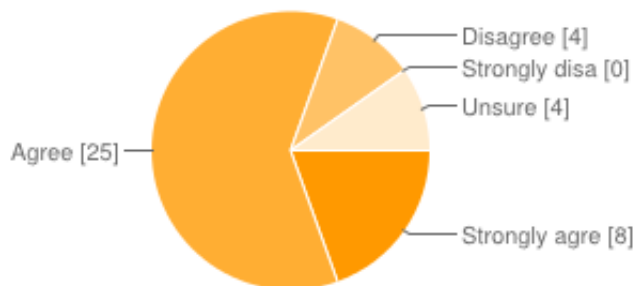

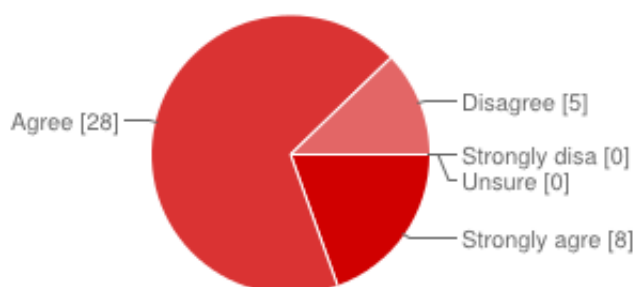
"Student learning is enhanced by the design of my school."

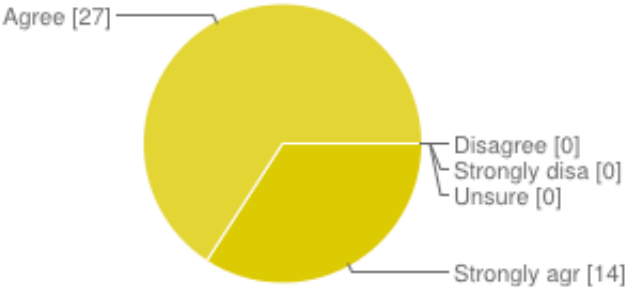

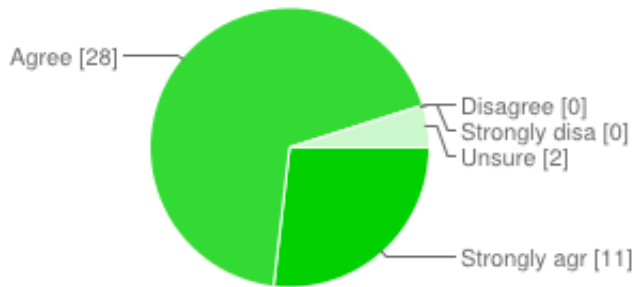

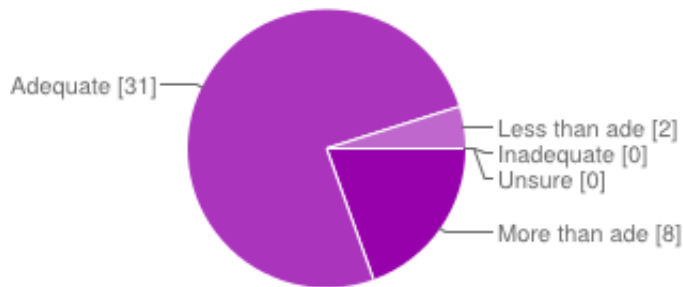

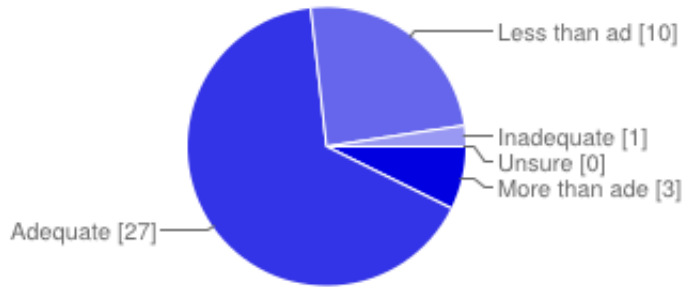

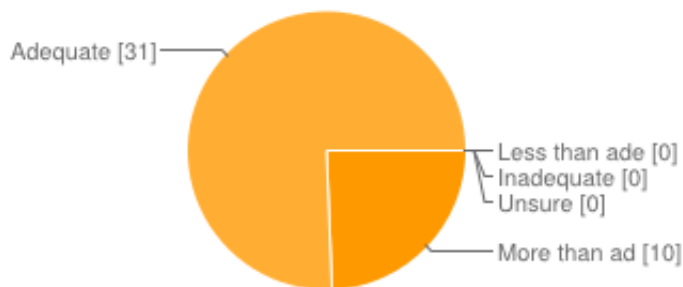

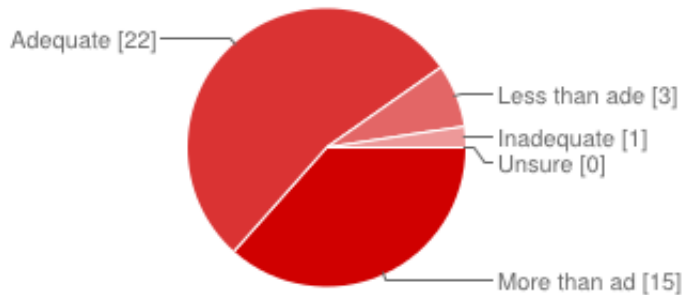

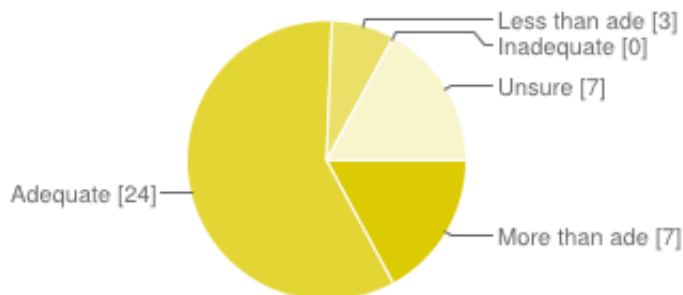

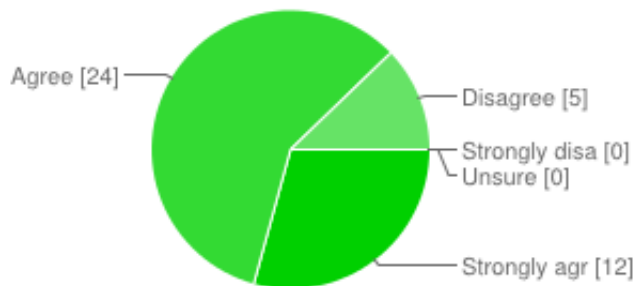

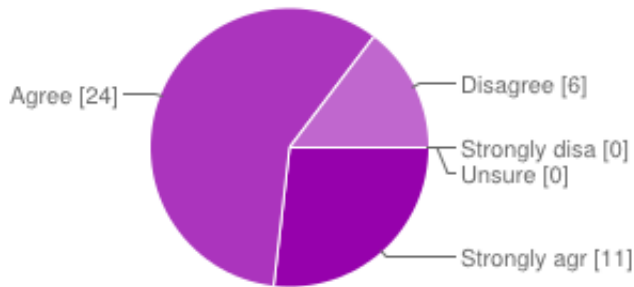

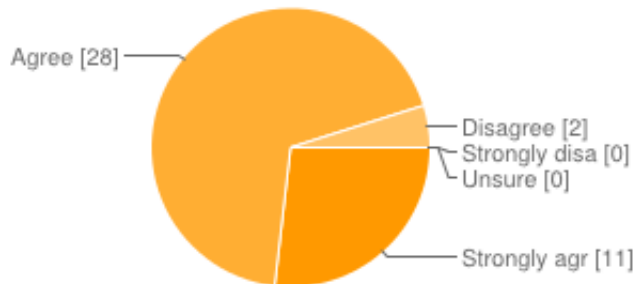

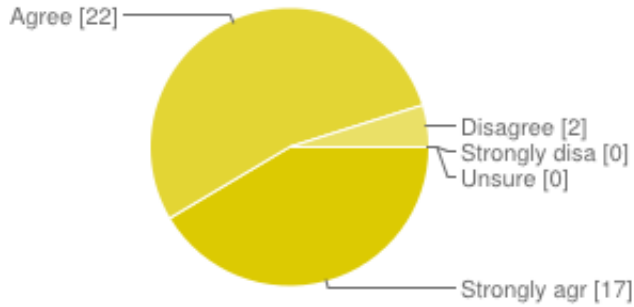

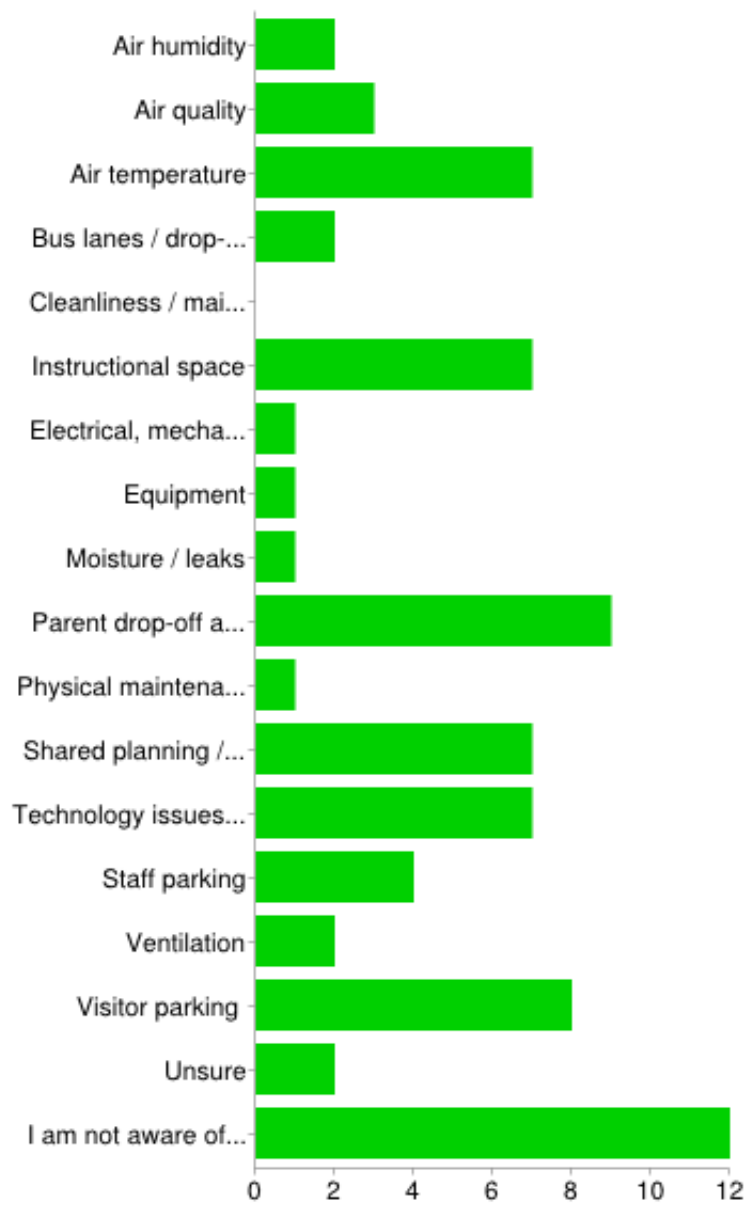
