Too close to children's playground. Often pull into lanes where staff are turning. Our pick up/drop off areas and procedures are more than adequate, but some parents continue to disregard how to use them. Can get congested with Saint Isaac Jogues School so near. The problem is more with parents not following the procedures that are in place. There are safety concerns with drop-off and pick-up. Many parents do not adhere to the no drop off in the front of the school - even though signs are posted. In the morning, I have seen many near accidents as parents stop in the no drop off zone to drop off kids to school early for band/clubs, etc. Parents that do pull into the parking lot to drop off, do a quick U-Turn and again I have seen and experienced near accidents due to this practice - even though the proper procedures have been explained and publicized for parents. Another area for safety concern is along Madison Street. Especially after school, I see many parents cross the street with students to quickly get to their cars as they park on the street instead of picking students up in

the drop off/pick up lane. Some parents, with their students, refuse to cross at the crosswalk where there is a crossing guard. Instead they cross in the middle of the street causing cars to have to stop quickly or causing traffic to back up.






"Student learning is enhanced by the design of my school."









How would you characterize the amount of shared meeting / working space in your building?











Most rooms have the mentioned equipment. Some projectors are not clear or distort colors. Not all classrooms have SMARTboards or speaker systems. There are not enough laptops and iPads for all of the teachers who want to work with them. We need some alternative way to gain access to projection. When holding meetings to analyze student data, it is very difficult to both participate in the meeting and sit in an area with your computer that is close enough to project via cord connection. We've asked for longer cords, but the solution has been less than ideal (cords literally suspended in the air across the room). There are many ways to do this wirelessly that allow for full mobility and shared access to project with technology (i.e. apple TV). phones....cannot use unless 630 area code would like more computers or ipads in the classroom






