

**Digital Learning Initiative Committee Meeting Notes:
Thursday, January 14, 2016 (3:30-5:30pm)**



Debrief / Board Learning Committee Meeting

Mary Morgan Ryan led a debrief of the Board Learning Committee meeting that took place on January 6, 2016, during which Digital Learning Initiative Committee members presented draft Belief Statements. Mary shared thanks to the committee for attending. She explained that it is the DLI Committee's hope that a decision on options would be made at the April 11 Board meeting.

Belief Statements / Community Events

Mary described suggested changes to the Belief Statements, which the committee reviewed together. She then outlined a plan for seeking community feedback on the Belief Statements, an idea suggested during the Learning Committee meeting. Engagement events will be held February 9 and February 10 at Prospect School (9:30am and 7pm). Members discussed starting each event with a video or slideshow, using tablets to capture comments / feedback, explaining the process the DLI Committee has been following, and possibly having students demo some of the technology they have been using in the classroom.
