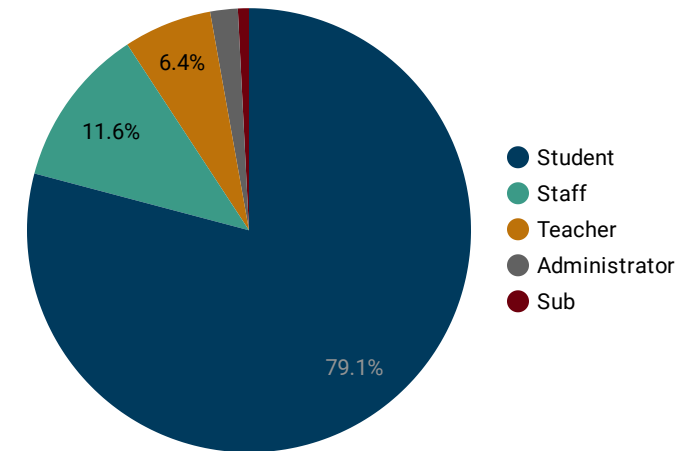

INFORMATION & TERMS DEFINED

This dashboard is a collection of internal data. These metrics are updated weekly at 4 p.m. on Mondays and include data up to the previous Friday. Exceptions made for non-student attendance days and holiday breaks.

TERMS DEFINED

Cumulative Total: We began tracking complete staff and student absence data with consistent coding starting Sept. 28, 2020, and are reported through the Friday prior to Monday posting. Positive cases have been tracked since the first day of school, Sept. 8, 2020, and are reported through the Sunday prior to Monday posting.

Staff: Teachers, staff members, and administrators. As of October 2020, we have 561 staff onsite.

Student: A student grade K-8 who is enrolled in in-person learning. As of April 2021, we have 3,275 total in-person students.

Absences: Days where an individual was unable to participate in in-person learning due to COVID-related symptoms, identification as a close contact, or a positive COVID test. Staff absences also include leave due to Emergency Family Medical Leave Act for COVID-related reasons.

Quarantine: Includes all students/staff out due to being a close contact (inside or outside of school), and/or students experiencing COVID-related symptoms, and/or siblings who are quarantined due to a symptomatic or COVID-positive sibling.

Sibling Absences: Students who are required to stay home because their sibling has COVID-related symptoms, been identified as a close contact, or has received a positive COVID test.
