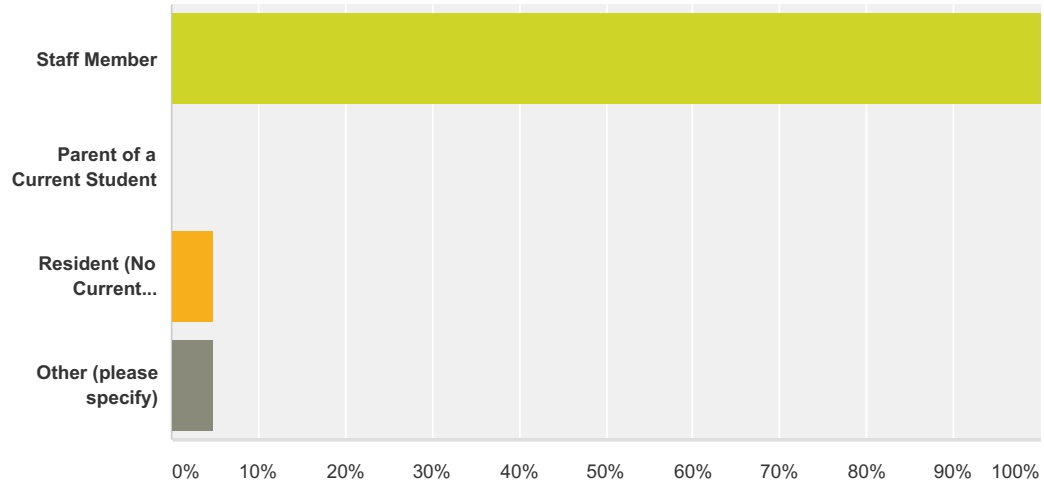


Q1 Are you a staff member, a parent of a current student, a resident with no current students, or are you from a different community group?

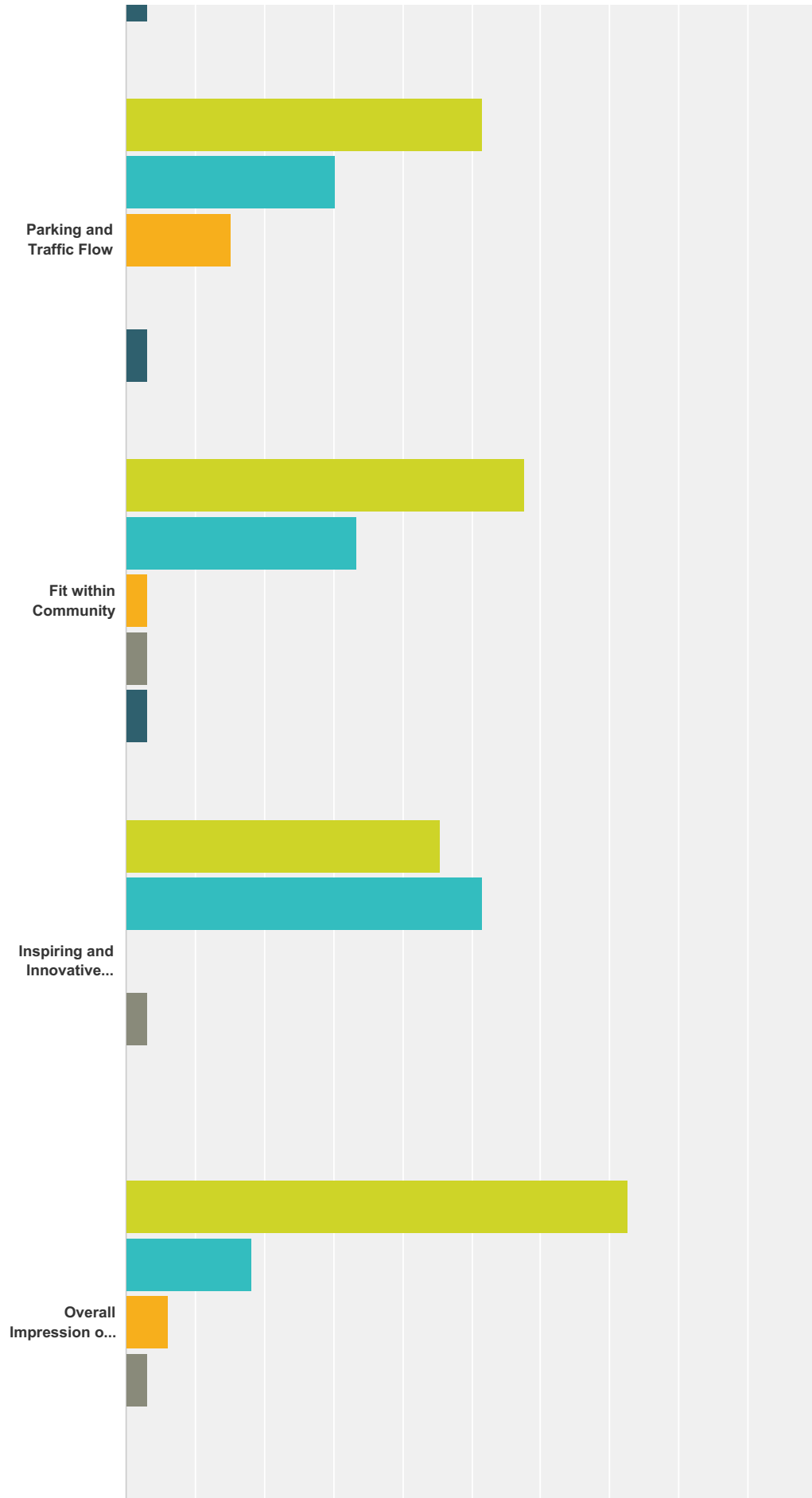
